Authority

- 1 AUTHORITY
- 1.1 The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Union-Yacht-Club Attersee (UYCAs) as sanctioned by the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (ISCYRA). The host fleet is Attersee Fleet (Att).



Rules

- 2 RULES
- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 2.2 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 2.3 RRS Appendix P will apply. P2.1 is changed to read, First and subsequent Penalties, will be a One-Turn Penalty under RRS 44.2. P2.2 and 2.3 are deleted.
- 2.4 RRS 32 will be changed. No course will be shortened. Per STCR 34.3.7, the length of a leg may be changed under RRS 33(b).



- 2.5 Under RRS 87, following rule(s) of the STCR are changed as follows:
- 2.5.1 STCR 34.3.7 will be changed.
 With permission of the Continental Committee Format C will be used not based on the number of competitors.
- 2.5.2 STCR 31.2.6 will be changed.

 The use of a VHF radio is not permitted by Austrian law.
- 2.6 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 2.7 The Sailing Instructions will be available latest at the beginning of registration on the official notice board and will be duplicated the event website.
- 2.8 If class rules do not require higher standards ISO-Norm 12402-5 (or equal) is the minimum requirement for personal floating devices.
- 2.9 The use of remote-controlled aircrafts (drones) over the racing area by accompanying or supporting persons is in addition to the legal provisions only permitted if this has been registered with and approved by the organizing authority.
- 2.10 There may be special Covid-19 regulations which have the status of a rule [DP]

Advertising

3 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

Eligibility and Entry

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 Entries eligible in accordance with STCR 21 and 26 may compete.
- 4.2 Skippers shall meet the requirements of STCR 23.7.3 "Youth" or "Junior" and shall not have reached his or her 30th birthday before the first race of the event.
- 4.3 Entries shall be submitted on the official online entry form no later than September 1st, 2023, to the Union-Yacht-Club Attersee. Entry link: Stars2023.uycas.at
- 4.4 Only skippers and crew eligible to compete under World Sailing Eligibility Regulations shall be eligible to compete in this regatta.
- 4.5 A competitor is not entered and will not receive a score until: (a) All fees are paid;
 (b) Measurement and crew weighing are completed; and
 (c) Proof of insurance is provided.
- 4.6 Late entries may be accepted till September 24th, 2023, in accordance with STCR 28.3.2.
- 4.7 According to the situation of Covid-19 pandemic it may be necessary to provide a negative PCR or negative antigen test or a completed vaccination at registration.



- Otherwise, the participation may not be allowed. Entered competitors will be informed in time personally via email and on the event website.
- 4.8 Boats and competitors of clubs or organizations affiliated with Russian (RUS) or Belarus (BLR) national authorities are not eligible to enter in accordance with the World Sailing Statement Concerning the Situation in Ukraine (sailing.org).

Fees

- 5 FEES
- 5.1 The entry fee is € 340,- for transfer to UYCAs (IBAN AT59 3436 3800 0001 9406;
 BIC RZOOAT2L363) until entry closing date (September 1st, 2023) with the index "U30 Europeans & Sailnumber & Skipper"
 € 390,- till the end of registration.
 - The entry fee includes boat and trailer storage, launching and hauling, and invitations to social events at the Union-Yacht-Club Attersee for skipper and crew.
- 5.2 No entry fee refunds will be made after the final entry due date of September 1st, 2023, except that if an entrant cannot comply or otherwise compete through no fault of her/his own, including travel restrictions not in place at the time of entry. All fees will be refunded in the case the event will be cancelled.

- 6 SCHEDULE
- 6.1 Registration:

Wednesday, September 27th, 2023, 15:00 – 18:00 hrs, Thursday, September 28th, 2023, 9:00 – 11:00 hrs

- 6.2 Equipment inspection and event measurement: Wednesday, September 27th, 2023, 15:00 18:00 hrs, Thursday, September 28th, 2023, 9:00 11:00 hrs
- Dates of racing:

 Thursday, September 28th, 2023 Saturday, September 30th. 2023
 On Sunday, October 1st, 2023, races will be sailed only if three races have not been completed. No fourth race will be sailed on Sunday, October 1st, 2023
- 6.4 Number of races:
 Two (2) races are scheduled for each day of racing. A maximum of three (3) races may be sailed in any one day.
- The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is Thursday, September 28th, 2023, 13:00 hrs.

 The scheduled time for the warning signals on Friday and Saturday is 10:30 hrs and will be posted officially on the official notice board.
- On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 14:00 hrs.

Measurement

- 7 MEASUREMENT
- 7.1 Measurement will take place at Union-Yacht-Club Attersee. Each participating boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate in the name of the current owner, and the boat weight certificate and a form with the button numbers of the sails used at the event. Only boats that have completed registration, paid all entry fees, and passed the prescribed measurement check procedure are entitled to race. A boat may be re-checked during the regatta.
- 7.2 A boat shall comply with RRS 78.1 at Thursday, September 28th, 2023, 11:00 hrs
- 7.3 Crews shall demonstrate compliance with crew weight limits in accordance with STCR 31.1.3 latest by 11.00 on Thursday, September 28th, 2023. Per STCR 31.1.3, there will be no random re-weighing during the regatta.
- 7.4 Each boat shall display the sail number and national letters as indicated on their official entry form and approved by the measurer.
- 7.5 Assigned bow numbers will be given to each competing boat and shall be affixed to the hull according to the Sailing Instructions.

Venue	9 9.1 9.2	VENUE The Union-Yacht-Club Attersee is located in the city of Attersee am Attersee on the west side of the lake. The racing area normally is close to the club.
The Courses	10	THE COURSES Courses will be according to STCR 34, Format C, as amended by this NOR and Sailing Instructions. Course 2 is approved by the Continental Committee.
Penalty System	11 11.1 11.2	PENALTY SYSTEM RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty as defined in RRS 44.2. Appendix T (Arbitration) will apply.
Scoring	12 12.1 12.2	SCORING The number of races scheduled is 7. 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series. (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. (b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
Support boats	13	SUPPORT BOATS Support boats shall not be allowed. STCR 31.1.4 shall apply to any Support Person and associated boats as defined in RRS Definitions.
Berthing	14	BERTHING Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the harbour. [DP]

Haul-out Restrictions	15 15.1 15.2	HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS Boats shall be craned in till Thursday, September 28th, 2023, 11:00 hrs latest. [DP] Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee. [DP]
Diving Equipment and Plastic Tools	16	DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta. [DP]
Radio Communication	17	RADIO COMMUNICATION Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. [DP]
Prizes	18 18.1 18.2 18.3 18.4	PRIZES Perpetual Trophies will be awarded in accordance with STCR 24. Series prizes will be awarded to the skipper and crew finishing 1st through 8th place. Daily prizes will be awarded to the skipper and crew finishing first in each race. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Insurance	20	INSURANCE Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of € 1.500.000 per incident or the equivalent.

Liability, Images, Data: The clauses, that apply to all regattas



General

Competitors commit with their entry and/or participation to follow the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the rules of good seamanship and any other valid rules for this event as well as the regulations of Sailing Federations and the legal standards and participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk in accordance with RRS 3 and accepting the Notice of Race.

The organizing authority, its associates and appointees accept no responsibility for any damage – howsoever caused – ashore and afloat, for example those of crew, material and financial loss, as far as permitted by applicable law. This exclusion of liability applies to the occurrence of damage before, during and after the event, but not (a) in the event of wilful intent or gross negligence, (b) for personal injury in the event of gross negligence, (c) for personal injury if, as an exception, § 6 / 1 / 9 KSchG would apply.

To the same extent, each participant waives his claims for damages against all persons who (a) are responsible for the implementation of the regatta (e.g. race director) or as referee and / or (b) who assist the organizer at his request or order.

The onus of presentation and the burden of proof in terms of the occurrence of damages is incumbent upon the competitors.

The organizing authority excludes liability for lost property or damage caused by third parties as well as unpredictable or unusual damage.

Recordings in sound and vision

By registering and/or participating, all participating persons declare that they agree that pictures and sound recordings of them and their boats/material may be taken and used for media coverage of the event and for their - also future - application, as well as for promoting the purposes of the organizing clubs may be published indefinitely.

Data

By registering and / or participating, all participants declare that they agree that the personal data they provide may be stored, used and passed on to higher-level sports organizations in the context of the organizational implementation of the event.

Minors

Declarations for under-age competitors have to be signed additionally by their legal representative or by a representative, who is authorized in writing for this particular case.

Other

The organisation of the event begins well in advance. Refunds of entry fee and travel expenses will not be provided. In exceptional cases(parts of)the entry fee (amounting to saved expenses) might be refunded -not in cases of force majeure.

Changes of the Notice of Race or other rules (eg sailing instructions) remain reserved, but will be announced in time.

All prizes (especially property and memory prizes) expire, if they are not taken during the prize giving ceremony.

The law of the Republic of Austria applies to questions that are not subject to the autonomy of the sport (association). The place of jurisdiction is the locally and factually competent court for Attersee am Attersee.

Worth knowing for our guests

Registration

The facilities of UYCAs are free available for guests which are registered for a regatta in the UYCAs for three days before and three days after the regatta (trailer and boat). For a longer duration of stay please ask and register in the office (sekretariat@uycas.at), this is only in exceptional cases possible.

If you arrive prior to the event please inform us obligatory that our harbormasters are available with the key for the gate and crane.

Youth accommodation

In the youth accommodation of UYCAs are limited places. Registration is required before closing date for the event. At registration in the office we ask for the payment of € 10,- per night for teenagers (€ 15,- per night for adults) for bedlinen, shower and cleaning.

Camping

For regatta guests arriving by camper, caravan or tent there is a campsite with a limited number of parking spaces in the club as well as sanitary facilities.

The use is only possible after an appointment per E-Mail to sekretariat@uycas.at and is possible only during the regatta or training event. The arrival is possible one day before the event and departure must be till noon after the event. Fee per night and camper, caravan or tent: € 10, -

Arrival

The best way to reach the Union-Yacht-Club Attersee is via A1 motorway. Leave A1 at exit "St. Georgen im Attergau". At the end of the motorway's exit turn left to direction "Attersee". Follow the road until you are in the village of Attersee and turn right at the T-crossing in Attersee to direction "Unterach am Attersee". About 1 km later, you reach UYCAs. There is a pedestrian crossing in front of the club.

In the information E-Mail we'll send you a code for our gates. You can open the gate to the parking area and the "Tor Süd" (situated shore-based on the right side of the street). Through the "Tor Süd" you'll come to the trailer parking area and to the rigging ladder. Please prepare everything there before you move to the berth or to the crane.
